

CA Childcare Instructor Contract

I, _____, hereby state that as a California EMS Safety Services, Inc. certified Childcare Instructor I will adhere to and complete the following terms and conditions:

1. Agree to all rules and regulations regarding EMS Safety Services, Inc. and the State of California as identified in section one of EMS Safety Instructor Manuals, the EMS Safety Training and Administration Manual (TAM), and the California Code of Regulations as it pertains to training CPR and First Aid to childcare providers in California.
2. Ensure compliance with California EMSA requirements regarding the instruction of asthma and inhaled medications training (consistent with the California Code of Regulations, Title 22, Division 9, Ch. 1.1).
3. Purchase stickers from the State of California EMSA and affix them to CPR and First Aid cards issued to employees of state licensed daycare centers to demonstrate compliance with CPR/first aid training as it pertains to the regulations of the State of California.
4. Use only official state rosters from the California EMSA when teaching EMS Safety Services, CPR and/or First Aid for Childcare Provider's courses to licensed daycare facility employees.
5. Send a copy of the state roster to the EMSA office in Sacramento, CA within 30 days of the course. The sticker numbers need to be added to the roster before sending.
6. When teaching CPR to a state licensed daycare facility employee, include instruction and testing in techniques for all ages: adult, child and infant (according to the California Code of Regulations, Title 22, Division 9, Ch. 1.1).
